We began to support this program in 1966 and annually contribute about \$500,000 for salaries and vans.

Funding for our State Major Project comes from individual donations, Lodge donations, the Elks National Foundation, and from various other groups such as Ladies' Auxiliaries and PER Associations. We have a goal this year of \$8.00 per member.

Our State Major Project is administered by the NY Elks Major Projects, Inc.,a 501(c)(3) corporation, and contributions are tax exempt. The Corporation supervises funding provided by the Elks National Foundation for
