

NEW YORK STATE ELKS ASSOCIATION SPRING CONVENTION 2019 HIGHLIGHTS



The 107th Annual Convention of the New York State Elks Association and Spring Meeting of the New York Elks Major Projects, Inc. was held at the Buffalo Grand Hotel in Buffalo, New York from May 16, 2019 to May 19, 2019. The convention was attended by members and quests representing Lodges from throughout the State. The convention began with an Opening Ceremony and Memorial Ceremony on Thursday evening, May 16th, 2019. The opening ceremony consisted of an invocation by State Chaplain, Father Michael Martini, the Pledge of Allegiance which was lead by West District SVP John Williams, introduction of Dias Dignitaries by Past State President Anthony Gilberti, a welcome from West District Deputy Gerald Claude, a State Association welcome from State President Stu Rishe and remarks from the Honorable David R. Carr. Music selections that included the Star Spangled Banner, America the Beautiful, and the Armed Forces Medley was provided by the Friends of Harmony.. The Memorial Ceremony immediately followed the opening Ceremony. During the Memorial Ceremony, 90 Past Exalted Rulers who passed away the past year were remembered. On Friday morning, May 17th, State President Stu Rishe called the Opening Business session to order. An Invocation by provided by Reverend Michael Martini, the Pledge of Allegiance by Americanism Chair Randall Pray and the National Anthem by Tom Abbott of Whitehall Lodge #1491. State President Rishe then introduced the Advisory Board members in attendance followed by remarks from Past Grand Exalted Ruler David R. Carr. This was followed by reports from the different committee chairs. Each outgoing Chairs was presented a Recognition Award. Following the committee reports, there were nominations for State Vice Presidents, Trustees and State President. The convention featured workshops on Friday and Saturday that were well attended by Association members. A highlight of the convention was a competitive Ritual Contest that saw Carthage Lodge #1762 repeat as State Ritual Champions with a score of 96.9129 to earn the opportunity to represent the NYSEA at the National contest in St. Louis Missouri. 


